hael Kutza, founder and longtime artis

Michael Kutza, founder and longtime artistic director of the Chicago International Film Festival, writes about his experience in "Starstruck: How I Magically Transformed Chicago into Hollowood for More Than 50 Years." His provocative sexy, colorful and irreverent memoir details the wild ride that made Chicago an essential cinematic destination. Published by Bear Manor Media, the tome traces Kutza's journey as the child of doctors growing up on Chicago's West Side who decided in his early 20s that his town desperately needed a truly international film event to call its own. With assistance from silent screen star Colleen Moore and the legendary director King Vidor, he launched the festival in 1965 that predated Sundance, Tribeca, and Toronto's festivals.




PRESIDENT'S CORNER


