SHE ALSO IS A GRADUATE STUDENT INSTRUCTOR AT THE SCHOOL SINCE JANUARY, 2024 AND WORKED AS AN ACQUISITION ASSISTANT EDITOR FOR ALLIUM, THE ONLINE JOURNAL OF POETRY & PROSE, FALL 2024 ISSUE. HER WRITINGS INCLUDE THE PUBLISHED SHORT STORY, "REMEMBER ME," WHICH WAS LONGLISTED FOR THE AFRITONDO SHORT STORY PRIZE IN 2021.

IT IS A BITTERSWEET AWARD THIS YEAR AS COLUMBIA COLLEGE CHICAGO IS DROPPING ITS MFA WRITING PROGRAM IN JUNE. 
